

Let's talk money:

The cost of the trip is **\$400 per person**.

This includes everything for the week (supplies, meals, housing, transportation, t-shirt, team fees, etc)

There is a \$50.00 non refundable deposit due by February 11 to hold a spot. Reservations will be taken after that date only as space allows.

There will be a minimal amount of spending money required per person. (there may be ice cream nearby!)

Stock sales will begin after Easter and other fund raisers will be scheduled if needed.

All fund raising is optional, but must be attempted to receive scholarship funds. Full balance for the trip is required by May 20.

You'll experience this relational neighborhood through a weekly church service held at the housing site. Evening activities include taking a trip downtown to Grant Park and Millennium Park, sharing a meal with local residents and participating in a tour of Paseo Boricua, the Puerto Rican District of Humboldt Park with a local pastor. YouthWorks has partnered with this community since 1999.

During the week, you may serve at community gardens, help at a nearby children's program, or assist in community beautification efforts.
